At recent championships we have had multiple state-age medallists. Three swimmers competed at the 2021 National Open Water Championships at Coolum with our swimmers achieving one silver and one bronze medal. We had one swimmer qualify for the World Junior Open Water Championships. We had five 2021 National Age Championship qualifiers and three swimmers competing in the Tokyo Olympics qualifying event in Adelaide. One BSC swimmer was recently selected for Swimming Australia's National Para Swimming Development Squad.

Not content to rest on its past laurels, BSC is determined to enter a new period of growth and renewal and write the next chapters in its proud history.

About the Role

You will be required to implement a program to motivate and develop swimmers to meet state and national age and open targets and achieve competitive success at this level.

The successful person will embrace positive ideals and values promoting an environment in which swimmers develop self-esteem, self-confidence, discipline, effective habits and motivation to succeed.

Your duties:

- Plan, deliver and manage the performance squad program.
- Oversee the performance squad strength and conditioning program at the Southwest Sports Centre and support the Physiotherapy Musculoskeletal Screening Program provided to our elite athletes.
- Oversee the dryland program for the development squads.
- Set the club target meet schedule (open water and pool) and attend these meets and club time trials as well as state and national swimming events.
- Work collaboratively with coaches, parents and the management committee and motivate swimmers to achieve swimming goals and attain successful competitive results at club, regional, state and national level.
- Assist the club's other coaches to identify swimming talent in our development squads and assist in guiding appropriate swimmers towards the performance squads.
- Work with swimmers and coaches and the club's management committee to promote, develop and grow the club.
- Mentor other coaches in their own coaching development and facilitate regular coaching meetings.
- Communicate in a positive, effective and timely manner with swimmers, parents, the club's management committee and other agencies as required.
- Participate in professional development opportunities (ASCTA, South West Region Development Program, Swimming WA).

About You

Minimum qualifications and experience at the time of appointment:

- Current ACSTA Advanced (previously silver) coaching licence (preferred).
- Experience and demonstrated success coaching swimming at a high-performance level.
- Excellent interpersonal and communication skills including the ability to develop strong collaborative working relationships with coaches, parents, technical officials, swimmers and the management committee.
- Ability to secure a Working with Children Card in WA
- Provide contact details of 2-3 professional referees who can confirm experience and qualifications and provide good character reference.
